Brief project description

This project is a collaboration between DPR, DOTI and the Mile High Floor District (MHFD). It will focus on three improvements in the current park: the section of Harvard Gulch that runs through the park will be dredged to remove sediment, the existing storm water connection from York street will be replaced with a larger pipe, and the existing pedestrian bridge will be removed and replaced with a new low flow crossing that meets DPR trail standards.
